Unit Title	Why This Is Important and Why Is It Taught at This Point?
	This is the first depth study which students undertake. It follows the teaching of World War One in year 8 and a depth unit on Holocaust with World War Two in year 9. Some of the content is familiar to the students and allows them to build confidence with building of exam technique.
Germany 1890-1945 Democracy and Dictatorship	This period study focuses on the development of Germany during a turbulent half century of change. It was a period of democracy and dictatorship – the development and collapse of democracy and the rise and fall of Nazism. Students will study the political, economic, social and cultural aspects of these two developments and the role ideas played in influencing change. They will also look at the role of key individuals and groups in shaping change and the impact the developments had on them
